

Tentative Itinerary – Logging & Forestry Study Tour – Germany, Canada & USA.

Travel Dates: 11th to 29th June

Places to Visit:

TRAVEL TIME: 11th/12th June – Depart Auckland for Munich, Germany *via Hong Kong or Los Angeles*

VISIT: 13th June – 16th June – KWF in-Forest Expo in Bopfingen, Baden-Wuerttemberg, Germany. We also plan to have social engagements with members of the German Forest Contractors Association who are keen to meet with our group.

Accommodation: In the medieval town of Noerdlingen. Rooms will be booked with a small family business in house more than 500 years old.

TRAVEL TIME: 17th June – Depart Munich for Vancouver *via London, GB*

VISIT: 18th – 26th June – Logging operations in coastal British Columbia hosted by members of the Truck Loggers Association and in Oregon state and if possible also in Washington state hosted by local loggers and industry suppliers in the area. These will be mainly cable logging operations but there will be other possibilities subject to availability of crews in the areas we visit closer to the time. In between the BC and USA legs of the trip there could be a day or two of free time.

Accommodation: Yet to be confirmed, but at the recommendation of TLA in Canada and industry supplier contacts in Oregon and Washington.

TRAVEL TIME: 27th June – Depart Vancouver for Auckland (arrive on 29th June)

Free Time: In between organised visits to the KWF In-Forest Expo and the North American logging operations there will be time available for you to find your way around on your own in or smaller groups.

Indicative Price: \$NZ9,600 per person.

The above ‘indicative’ price is for airfares, group ground transportation and accommodation in Germany, British Columbia, Canada and Oregon, USA and is subject to change until final bookings and payment are made. All other costs are excluded so please note you would be well-advised to account separately for the likes of visas (you will require a visa for travel through or into USA), airport departure taxes, food and drink, travel insurance etc, etc.
