This training will give you a better understanding of the forest and wood industry, allowing you to make informed decisions as to where you want to work within the forestry industry.

- Aged 16+
- Entry interview

- Drug-free (will be drug tested as part of pre-entry into employment)

On completion of the Base Camp Programme you may be placed into paid employment, with pastoral care support; your own personalised training plan, for 6 months, and options for further training, up to 2 years.

Further training opportunities are available from Level 4 through to Diploma and Degree.
